
With Cheque.

Chief,-

I enclose herewith cheque No. 1300 for \$25.00 to defray the expenses of certain Indians whom you are to take from Oka to Montreal to act as witnesses and interpreter in the Oka case which comes up again for trial on the 13th instant. You should be careful to keep a strict account of the expenditure incurred and forward a statement of the same to the Department, together with receipts for payments made for board, etc.

In this connection I have to request that you will immediately account for the balance of cheque No. 1156 for \$75.00 sent you on the 2nd February to pay travelling expenses and board of Indians who went from Oka to Montreal as witnesses in the Oka case.
