



Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 17th instant, and the account amounting to \$3.50 which you have forwarded from Dr Bowles; and in reply I return the same herewith, and I have to inform you that in view of the circumstances set forth in your letter, and also as the account is not large, the Department will pay it. You may therefore certify to the same and return it to Headquarters. The Department desires that you will at the same time instruct Dr Bowles that if Indians go to him in future for treatment he should send them to the salaried physician Dr Jacques.
