Sir:-


Referring to your letter of the 3rd instant, I beg to confirm the following telegram sent you yesterday, viz:-

"Ship five hundred pounds tea to Onion Lake  
"Protestant School and order bacon from Griffin-Writings"

It will not be necessary for you to return Rev. Mr. Matheson's cheque for the tea, you should endorse it and forward it to the Department.

If Mr. Matheson does not want the cost of the bacon charged against the grant of his school, as in the case of the tea, he should pay the contractors himself as he did on previous occasions. I herewith return Mr. Matheson's letter.
