
Ottawa, May 1st., 1918.

Sir,-

Referring to your letter of the 24th ultimo, and the enclosure therewith submitted, relative to work on the Restigouche Reserve, I have to request that you will forward to the Department the account of the Chaleurs Bay Mills for the lumber which they supplied.
