Dear Sir,-

I have your letter of the 18th instant in which state that owing to the resignation of Miss Olive E. Gill, the name of Miss Dora E. Cox will appear on your pay list clerk in your office.

I would point out that all appointments must be by the Civil Service Commission, and that Miss Cox cannot be paid until such time as her appointment is made in the regular way. It is necessary to submit to the Commission a full report on the duties and salary of the position and also the qualifications and experience of the applicant. The passing of a competitive examination is necessary before a permanent appointment can be made.
