A. PURPOSES OF CONFERENCE:

1. To appraise the Post-war situation and determine what should be done to prepare adequately for it to the end that after the war the Canadian people will be assured the highest possible standard of living and a full measure of social and economic security.
2. To ascertain if the human and material resources and the productive capacity of Canadian Industry are sufficient to make this physically possible.
3. To determine how it can be made financially possible to every Canadian Citizen.
4. To decide the right and proper allocation of responsibility as between the Federal and the Provincial Governments for the implementation and administration of Post-war programs and proposals.
