sworn states:

On 14 Feb 45 I was ordered by Dr. P.O. at
0005 hrs. ^{15 Feb 45} Gnr Saylor whom I recognize as
one of the accused, reported in to me. At 0010 hrs.
15 Feb 45
Gnr Sullivan whom I recognize as one
of the accused reported in to me. Gnr Sullivan
appeared to have been drinking and Gnr Saylor
appeared to be sober. Gnr Sullivan demanded
to see an Officer and Capt Wyld was called
and came to the orderly room where Gnr Sullivan
was at the time.

Gnr Examined

I had a conversation with Sgt Boulton
in the orderly room at 2215 hrs 14 Feb 45.
Rattos roll call is at 2230 hrs, daily. After
Saylor reported to me he retired, later I was
instructed to parade him and he was very
hard to make.
