

receipt of price quoted I will ship you a ten pound caddy to your nearest railway station (if inside my freight district), freight prepaid, and if it is not satisfactory to you, it may be returned at my expense, and I will refund your money at once.

My sales for tea are ever on the increase, and in buying from me you are sure not to receive any old stock. You are probably aware that some of the tea which you buy may have been in the wholesale for some time, when it is bought by some retail merchant who has it in stock a longer or shorter time, which does not add to its strength or flavor.

I will ship you ten pounds of Tea, freight paid, to your nearest railway station, but cannot ship less than twenty pounds of Tea Siftings alone.

If you are not prepared to send a general order for goods, I will ship a ten pound caddy of Tea, and if it is not satisfactory you can return it at my expense of freight, and I will refund your money.

I will put my teas up in five, ten, fifteen, twenty and twenty-five pound caddies, at list prices; but if you order by the half-chest, I will allow a reduction of $2\frac{1}{2}$ cents per pound off all teas, except Siftings.

A half-chest of tea contains from 60 to 80 pounds.

In Lodges, where there are a number of parties ordering tea to the amount of fifty pounds or over, I can put it up in five and ten pound paper parcels, and pack it in a half chest, and allow you $2\frac{1}{2}$ cents per pound reduction off each kind, but in no instance can I ship less than fifty pounds at the reduced rate.
