4. The Secretary, Treasurer, or Librarian may appoint such assistants as may at any time by deemed necessary by the Executive Committee.

5. A Library Committee may be appointed by the Pastor, the Superintendent, and the Librarian who shall assist the Librarian in the selection of the books.

6. The Teachers shall be appointed by the Superintendent and at all times shall be subject to change or removal by him.

7. The officers, excepting the Superintendent, shall be elected at the annual meeting of the officers and teachers of the school, which shall be held not less than one week nor more than two weeks before the annual meeting of the church. Such election shall be void unless approved by the church.

Article X. Auxiliary Organizations.

1. There may be, among both the adults and the young people auxiliary organizations for the cultivating of interest in missions and in Christian education, not otherwise provided for.

2. Such organizations shall report to the church the object of their work, and shall keep the church informed of any modification of the same. They shall at all times be subject to the approval of the church,
