WHITE, RED, GREEN, BLUE, BROWN and ORANGE.

Each 5 lb. bundle contains 9,000 yards in length, and makes a length of carpet in proportion to the number of ends in width.

BALL KNITTING COTTON,

In all Numbers and Colors, put up in 2 oz. Balls.

2 lbs. in each box, made from the finest long staple cotton, especially selected for the purpose. This cotton is very carefully spun, and will be found to be evenly made and correctly numbered. Particular care is taken to have the dyeing and bleaching perfectly done. **FULL WEIGHT IN EVERY BALL.**
