inefficacy of the faid Laws: Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majefty, by and with the advice and confent of the Legislative Council and Affembly of the Province of Lower Canada, conftituted and affembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act paffed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "An Act to " repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, " intituled, " An Act for making more effectual Provision for the Government of the Province " of Quebec in North America," and to make further Provision for the Government of " the faid Province," and it is hereby enacted by the authority aforefaid, that from and after the paffing of this Act, it shall be lawful for the Justices of the Peace, and they are hereby authorifed in the Terms of the General Quarter Seffions of the Peace, held in the Diffricts of Quebec, Montreal and Three Rivers, respectively, to make Rules and Regulations to restrain rule and govern the faid Apprentices. Domesticks, hired-Servants and Journeymen, and also to make Rules and Regulations for the conduct of Masters and Mistreffes, towards their faid Apprentices, hired-Servants and Journeymen, which faid Rules and Regulations shall not have force and effect, until they shall have been approved of by the Courts of King's Bench, for the Districts of Quebec, Montreal and Three Rivers, respectively. Provided always, that nothing herein contained, shall be understood to give power or authority to the faid Juffices of the Peace, in virtue of the Rules and Regulations which they are hereby authorifed to make, as aforefaid, to inflict upon the faid Apprentices, Domefticks, hired-Servants or Journeymen, for any Breach or contravention by them committed, against the faid Rules and Regulations, a greater Fine than Ten Pounds current money of this Province, or Two Months imprisonment or confinement, in the Houses of Correction, in the respective Districts aforesaid. And Provided allo, that the faid Rules and Regulations, shall be subject to the same Formalities, Rules and Provisions, as are prescribed by the Act intituled, " An AE to provide for the more effectual Regulation " of the Police within the Cities of Quebec and Montreal, and the Town of Three Kivers; " alfo for extending Regulations of Police to other Towns and Villages, in certain cafes, and " for repealing the Atts or Ordinances therein mentioned."

II. And be it further enacted, by the authority aforefaid, that this Act and the Rules and Regulations made under the authority thereof, fhall continue and be in force, until the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and three, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of the Provincial Parliament, and no longer.
