

Household Hints.

CREAMED POTATOES. -Chop twelve cold boiled potatoes, add one cup milk, and pepper and salt to taste. Boil twenty minutes, being careful that it does not burn

APPLE FRITTERS .- One cup of flour, one teaspoonfulfof baking powder, one pinch of salt, two eggs, one cup of milk. Sift the flour, salt and powder together, add the eggs beaten, the the milk, one-half pint of chopped apple and a little nutmeg. Mix into a hatter as for griddle cakes and door a batter as for griddle cakes, and drop

LEMON PUDDING. A very good pudding may be made from one small cup of butter, two full cups of sugar, mix very smooth, adding then to the grated rind of two lemons the yelks of six eggs, six small Boston crackers dissolved in one pint of sweet milk. Bake and use the whites of the eggs to make a meringue for the top of the pudding. When the whites are beaten stiff add six tablespoonsful of powdered sugar; mix well, spread on top of pudding and brown nicely.
