

- (b) export permits and exit and entry visas, where applicable, for members of the Canadian personnel and their dependants and for the materials, equipment and personal effects of Canadian firms and Canadian personnel.

ARTICLE XII

Any dispute arising in connection with the interpretation and application of the provisions of this Agreement or a subsidiary arrangement or loan agreement shall be resolved by means of negotiations between the Government of Canada and the Government of Senegal or in any other manner agreed upon by both Governments.

ARTICLE XIII

This Agreement shall enter into force on the date on which each Government shall have notified the other that all constitutional formalities have been complied with. It is concluded for a period of three years and shall be tacitly extended for another period of equal duration. It may be terminated by either Government giving to the other six months written notice to that effect. After the expiry of this Agreement its provisions shall remain in effect with regard to previously agreed projects until full completion of said projects.

ARTICLE XIV

This Agreement shall terminate and replace the Understanding of 21 September 1966.
