

(f) in the case of lending of exhibits, the person or class of persons who will have custody of the exhibit, the place to which the exhibit is to be removed, any tests to be conducted and the date by which the exhibit will be returned.

3. If the Requested Party considers that the information contained in the request is not sufficient to enable the request to be dealt with, that Party may request that additional details be furnished.

4. A request shall be made in writing. In urgent circumstances or where otherwise permitted by the Requested Party, a request may be made orally but shall be confirmed in writing promptly thereafter.

ARTICLE 7

AVAILABILITY OF PERSONS TO GIVE EVIDENCE OR ASSIST INVESTIGATIONS IN THE JURISDICTION OF THE REQUESTING PARTY

1. A request may be made for assistance to facilitate :

(a) the availability of a person to assist in an investigation, or
