University to university agreement for student exchange for up to four students. Currently, the program is prepared to be open to faculty as well. In 1994, two students from each university studied at the partner university. Although the agreement is open to students from all areas of Arts and Sciences, Marburg students primarily take Canadian Studies courses at the University of Saskatchewan and students from the University of Saskatchewan take European Studies courses.

Students are selected by an ad-hoc committee of the home university and remain enrolled at their home university. Travel and accommodation costs are paid by the participants, as are the costs of living as well. Students only pay a small "student-related fee" at the partner university. The exchange lasts one academic year (September to May).
