The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Howard Green, announced today the appointment of Mr. Graham Campbell McInnes as Canada's first High Commissioner to Jamaica.

Born in London, England, in 1912, Mr. McInnes studied at the University of Melbourne. Before joining the Department of External Affairs in 1948, he had been Art Editor of Saturday Night, lecturer in art at the Extension Department of the University of Toronto and Senior Producer and Co-ordinator of Graphics for the National Film Board.

Since joining the Department, Mr. McInnes has held posts abroad in New Delhi, Wellington and London. He is serving at the present time with the Office of the High Commissioner in London as Minister. In Ottawa, Mr. McInnes has been Head of Commonwealth Division and Chief of Protocol.

Mr. McInnes is married and has three children. He will take up his new appointment as High Commissioner to Jamaica in the near future.
