The House will now divide on motion No. 7. The question is as follows: Moved by Mr. Comeau:

(7) That Bill C-144, An Act to provide for the management of the water resources of Canada including research and the planning and implementation of programs relating to the conservation, development and utilization of water resources be amended by adding a new clause 6A as follows:

"6A. (1) Forthwith upon the coming into force of this Act, the Governor in Council, upon the recommendation of the Minister, shall establish water quality standards for all classes of water in Canada.

(2) No person shall deposit or permit the deposit of waste in any waters in Canada that fall below

the minimal water quality standard established for those waters under subsection (1); violation of this subsection shall be deemed to be an offence and punishable under section 22."
