THE CONJUNCTION.

§79. A Conjunction is a word used merely to connect the parts of a sentence.

Conjunctions are also *Simple* (as, cho, as, so ; gu, gur, that ;) and *Compound* (as air an aobhar sin, therefore ; ach coma co dhiù, nevertheless, notwithstanding.)

Some Conjunctions are used in pairs and are said to be co-relative ; as cho.....ri, so.....as ; an.....neo, whether.....or ; araon.....agus, both.....and.

THE INTERJECTION.

§80. An Interjection is a word or phrase of exclamation denoting some strong emotion, but not entering into the grammatical construction of the sentence ; as, hacidh ! hallo ! seall ! faic ! feuch ! behold ! lo ! thugad ! hook it ! ho ró ! huzza !
