THE SENATE OF CANADA

BILL S9.

An Act for the relief of Ethelynne Joan Ratcliff Gauvreau.

Preamble.

WHEREAS Ethelynne Joan Ratcliff Gauvreau, residing at the city of Westmount, in the province of Quebec, wife of Joseph Gustave Gaston Gauvreau, who is domiciled in Canada and residing at Roxboro, in the said province, has by her petition alleged that they were married on the 5 tenth day of November, A.D. 1951, at the city of Montreal, in the said province, she then being Ethelynne Joan Ratcliff, a spinster; and whereas by her petition she has prayed that, because of his adultery since then, their marriage be dissolved; and whereas the said marriage and adultery have 10 been proved by evidence adduced and it is expedient that the prayer of her petition be granted: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

Marriage dissolved.

1. The said marriage between Ethelynne Joan Ratcliff 15 and Joseph Gustave Gaston Gauvreau, her husband, is hereby dissolved, and shall be henceforth null and void to all intents and purposes whatsoever.

Right to marry again.

2. The said Ethelynne Joan Ratcliff may at any time hereafter marry any man whom she might lawfully marry if 20 the said marriage with the said Joseph Gustave Gaston Gauvreau had not been solemnized.
