

THE SENATE OF CANADA

BILL S<sup>o</sup>.

An Act for the relief of Ethelynnne Joan Ratcliff Gauvreau.

Preamble.

WHEREAS Ethelynnne Joan Ratcliff Gauvreau, residing at the city of Westmount, in the province of Quebec, wife of Joseph Gustave Gaston Gauvreau, who is domiciled in Canada and residing at Roxboro, in the said province, has by her petition alleged that they were married on the tenth day of November, A.D. 1951, at the city of Montreal, in the said province, she then being Ethelynnne Joan Ratcliff, a spinster; and whereas by her petition she has prayed that, because of his adultery since then, their marriage be dissolved; and whereas the said marriage and adultery have been proved by evidence adduced and it is expedient that the prayer of her petition be granted: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

Marriage dissolved.

1. The said marriage between Ethelynnne Joan Ratcliff and Joseph Gustave Gaston Gauvreau, her husband, is hereby dissolved, and shall be henceforth null and void to all intents and purposes whatsoever.

Right to marry again.

2. The said Ethelynnne Joan Ratcliff may at any time hereafter marry any man whom she might lawfully marry if the said marriage with the said Joseph Gustave Gaston Gauvreau had not been solemnized.
