

ability resulting from loss of sight, hand, arm or leg, or from some severe spinal injury, and in the event of such disability, the member so injured shall be entitled to receive fifty cents from each member; but the widow, if any, and if none, the child or children, shall only receive the sum of fifty cents from each member at his death; and in case there shall be no widow or children of such member, then the sum, payable as aforesaid, shall be for the benefit of the next of kin; and the sum of one dollar, payable by each on the death of any member, shall be paid and payable in the same manner.

7.—It shall be the duty of the Executive Committee to examine the accounts half-yearly, and to see that the business of the Association is honestly and properly conducted.

8.—Each member shall be entitled to a certificate of membership under the seal of the Association, which shall be attached by the President and Secretary, and signed by them.

9.—An annual fee of one dollar will be required of each member, payable at the call of the Secretary, on the 27th day of December in each year, for the purpose of defraying expenses, but such sum will not be called for when the Secretary shall consider that he has sufficient funds on hand to meet the expenses of the coming year.

10.—The Secretary shall, as soon as convenient, notify each member of the death or disability of any member or members, as aforesaid, and require the amount of one dollar for each of such deaths from every member of the Associa-
