## 48 ONTARIO AS A HOME FOR THE BRITISH TENANT FARMER.

Farm labourers with families can find ready employment 'f they are experienced and have the means of providing a little furnities and provisions. If there are young women in the family, able and willing to take places as servants, so much the better.

The demand for female domestic servants is constant everywhere throughout the Province at all seasons of the year. The rate of wages for experienced servants ranges from \$6 to \$12 per month with board. Good general servants can readily find employment at from \$7 to \$10 per month on their arrival. Young women, however, who are not able or willing to work will not succeed in the Province.
