**GRAINS ARE STRONGER
BUT STILL UNSTEADY**

Futures on All Cereals Close Higher
at Chicago - Liverpool Also
Quotes Higher.

Thursday Evening, March 7.
Liverpool wheat futures closed today 3/4
to 1/2 higher than yesterday, and corn fu-
tures 3/4 higher.

At Chicago May wheat closed 1/2 cen-
t higher than yesterday; May corn 1/2 cen-
t higher; May oats 1/2 cen. higher; and
May soybean oil 1/2 cen. higher.
