Chicago Again Depressed With Liverpool. Natural Reaction From War Scare - Delivers Large in the United States - Bears News From India, Russia and Argentina - Contradictory Antipodean Reports - Notes and Gossip.

Friday Evening, Nov. 4. British, American and French wheat markets were again depressed today, doubtless owing to a reaction from the recent war scare.

Liverpool futures were weak, closing 1/2 cent lower than yesterday. Paris per cental closed 5 centimes, with flour 25 centimes off.

Chicago futures followed soft, declining about 1/2 cent per bushel below last night's closing figures. To the depressing cables were added the latest reports from India and Russia.

Liverpool market closed 1/2 cent lower than yesterday. Chicago corn futures were a small fraction, but steady all day.

Peas declined 1/4 at Liverpool today. Colored cheese advanced 1/4 at Liverpool today.
