



NEW THEORY OF CANCER.

Cleveland, March 30.—Before the American Association of Pathologists and Bacteriologists to-day Dr. Lecount of Chicago presented a paper in which he said that the so-called parasites of cancer were not parasites, but parts of cells, thus clashing with the widely accepted parasite theory of cancer.

Manila, March 31.—Major Littleton W. T. Waller of the Marine Corps testified in his own behalf to-day at his trial by court-martial on the charge of killing natives of the Island of Samar without trial. He graphically described the hardships the marines endured, owing to the treachery of the natives, and the attempted robbery of arms, and said he was not aware that the guide, Victor, was a notorious and infamous insurgent captain, who had led insurgents at Bassy and Balangiga, otherwise he would not have allowed Victor to go with the party. The Major also said he carried out Gen. Smith's orders entirely, and never went beyond them, except in the last paragraph of Waller in Own Behalf. them, except in the last paragraph of the order which he issued on taking command, calling on the latter to avenge the slaughter at Balangiga of their comrades of the 9th Infantry in the Chinese expedition. Every other act Gen. Smith absolutely inspired.

Ottawa, March 31.—Pte. W. E. Bennett and Pte. C. S. Scott of the 43rd. Capt. Rennie of the Queen's Own and Staff-Sergt. Bayles of the Royal Grenadiers have taken places on the Bisley team. Sergt.-Major Ross of the 77th is unable to go. The D.R.A. executive is having plans prepared for a new building for competitors to be put up at Rockliffe this summer. The Bisley team will almost certainly have a place in the coronation procession.
