Allotment of Time for Bill C-11

This bill has been around since last spring when the then minister of finance, the hon. member for Rosedale, presented his budget. We have already passed two or three bills which he presented. What is in this bill is not new. The additions brought down by the Minister of Finance in his so-called mini-budget were not extensive in terms of technicalities.

He also made the point that members opposite did not understand the proposals they were criticizing. Even in some answers by the Minister of Finance, he was not as fully informed as he ought to have been.

Mr. Reid: That ought not to be surprising because of the technicalities. At least the minister has access to some advice because of the House practices, where the opposition has none. The only point I am trying to make is that it is absolute madness-

Mr. Stevens: On a point of order—

Mr. Dionne (Northumberland-Miramichi): Oh, sit down.

Mr. Stevens: I feel that the record should be constantly brought up to date. I have just received another amendment that will be proposed to be made during the committee of the whole stage. There will be nine amendments that we know of so far which the Minister of Finance (Mr. Chrétien) will be making.

Mr. Chrétien: That is true, Mr. Speaker, but we are not even sure how many days it will take to get to clause 14. Perhaps that will only be on Friday afternoon. In addition, it is an amendment that is desired by members of parliament. It is all related. It is to make sure that further changes on this question of insurance companies will be brought about. I have listened to representations by members of this House as well as from outside. If members opposite do not want it, we will not have it, but we will know who to blame. It is important that the people of Canada know that we are completely on their side. It is about time we decided who is running this nation.
