

THE ROYAL FAMILY.

The Queen.—Victoria, Queen of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland; only daughter of his late Royal Highness Edward, Duke of Kent; born May 24, 1819; succeeded to the throne on the decease of her uncle, William IV., June 20th, 1837; Proclaimed June 21st; Crowned June 28th, 1838; Married February 10th, 1840, to Field Marshal His Royal Highness Prince Albert Augustus Charles Emanuel, Prince of Saxe Cobourg and Gotha, Knight of the Most Noble Order of the Garter, &c.

Issue—Victoria Adelaide Mary Louisa (Princess Royal), born Nov. 21, 1840. Albert Edward (Prince of Wales), born November 9, 1841. Alice Maud Mary, born April 25, 1843. Alfred Ernest Albert, born August 6, 1844. Helena Augusta Victoria, born May 25, 1846. Louisa Carolina Alberta, born March 18, 1848. Arthur Patrick, born May 1st, 1850.

THE QUEEN'S MOTHER—Victoria, Duchess of Kent; daughter of Francis, Duke of Saxe Cobourg, born August 17, 1786; Married May 29, 1818, to Edward, Duke of Kent, who died January 23rd, 1828. Issue—the Queen.

UNCLE AND AUNT OF THE QUEEN.—Ernest Augustus, Duke of Cumberland (King of Hanover) born June 5th, 1770; Mary, Duchess of Gloucester, born April 25, 1776.
