



THE ROYAL FAMILY.

THE QUEEN.—*Victoria*, Queen of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland; only daughter of his late Royal Highness Edward, Duke of Kent; born May 24, 1819; succeeded to the throne on the decease of her uncle, William IV., June 20th, 1837; Proclaimed June 21st; Crowned June 28th, 1838; Married February 10th, 1840, to Field Marshal His Royal Highness Prince Albert Augustus Charles Emanuel, Prince of Saxe Cobourg and Gotha, Knight of the Most Noble Order of the Garter, &c.

ISSUE.—*Victoria Adelaide Mary Louisa* (Princess Royal), born Nov. 21, 1840. *Albert Edward* (Prince of Wales), born November 9, 1841. *Alice Maud Mary*, born April 25, 1843. *Alfred Ernest Albert*, born August 6, 1844. *Helena Augusta Victoria*, born May 25, 1846. *Louisa Carolina Alberta*, born March 18, 1848. *Arthur Patrick*, born May 1st, 1850.

THE QUEEN'S MOTHER.—*Victoria*, Duchess of Kent; daughter of Francis, Duke of Saxe Cobourg, born August 17, 1786; Married May 29, 1818, to Edward, Duke of Kent, who died January 23rd, 1828. **Issue.**—the Queen.
