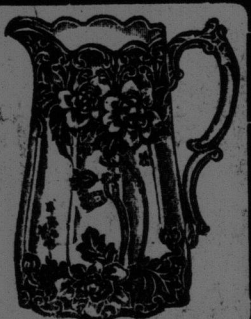

**LABOR COUNCIL WANTS
TAX EXEMPTION AND
NEW BUILDING LAW**

Taxation and housing problems were discussed last evening at a meeting of the Trades and Labor Council and among those taking part were F. Hyatt, J. E. Tighe, Charles Stevens, H. E. O'Donnell, George Kierstead, Bayard Stillwell, H. Campbell, Frank Sharpe, B. Hurley, and the president, J. L. Sugrue. The sentiments of the meeting were crystallized in the following resolutions: Whereas, the taxation system of St. John is in the opinion of this meeting a farce, as practically the only people paying the full assessment are the workers earning under \$1,000 a year, it being seemingly impossible to arrive at the incomes of those who are earning over this amount; Resolved, that this meeting request the Common Council to pass Commissioner Pott's resolution for exemption on incomes; Resolved, also, that further legislation be enacted compelling true statements from merchants, or in event of their failing to comply with the law in this regard, compelling the assessors to make a true and more complete valuation; Whereas, the building by-law of St. John is entirely inadequate for present conditions; And whereas, there is seemingly no regulation in regard to the proper construction of homes, allowing land-owners and real estate to construct a flimsy and poor class of home, from which they are able to derive a much greater profit on investment; Therefore be it resolved, that this meeting request the Common Council to prepare for enactment at the coming session of the legislature an up-to-date building by-law.

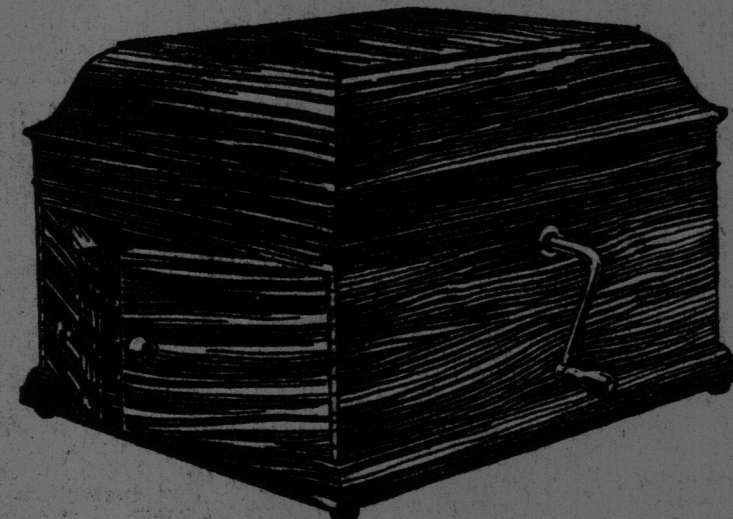

MARINE NOTES
The royal mail steamer Corsican, Captain Hull, arrived in port this morning from Halifax. It is the steamer's first

trip to this port this season. During the last six months she was engaged carrying troops from England to France and Egypt. Among the passengers who arrived at Halifax on the Corsican were nineteen men from Salisbury Plain who had been sent home as invalids or undischarges.

According to a wireless message received at Cape Race, Nfld, the crew of the schooner Fleet, 174 tons, of Lunenburg, N. S., were picked up by the steamer Mechanician bound for Europe. The schooner was abandoned at sea.

Flour and Wheat Census.

The C. P. R. has been notified by the Canadian government to make a report of the quantity of wheat and flour which the railway has in its charge while in transit. It is believed that this may indicate the government is considering the advisability of steps to regulate the price of flour.
