The next move of the union was to draft a comprehensive law, "to restrict the temptations offered by the multitude of public houses and shops where schnaps was sold." This was followed by a declaration of the civil incapacity of dangerous drunkards. Confirmatory bills have been agreed to by the ministers at Berlin and now await the approval of the legislative bodies. The next move of the Union was in the direction of supplanting the liquor shops by the establishment of coffee houses and midday dinner kitchens. A profitable business is done in many of the large cities in supplying good coffee at 1½ cents a cup and substantial dinners at ten cents each.
