

New York. N. Y., July 20,—The stock market today might be said to have been waiting on the return of J. P. Morgan, whose arrival from Europe is expected temorrow. The aggressive pushers of the recent advance in United States Steel were disturbed by a suggestion that the expected increase in the dividend had not been crease in the dividend had not been determined on and might be considered as improbable. This was taken to mean that some of the interests in the property believe in postponing the contemplated increase in the rate of disbursement until the working off of orders taken at the deep cut in prices which went into effect in February may open the way to business on a more profitable basis. Holders of United States Steel above 70 do not view with equaninity the prospect of continuing to hold the stock as a 2 per cent dividend payer and even the suggestion of a 3 per cent rate leaves a lack of assurance amongst recent speculative buyers.

Amongst these the assumption has been that J. P. Morgan had committed himself to the advocacy of a policy of increased dividends in connection with the negotiations to introduce United States Steel to the Paris Bourse. The stock which was taken by the French syndicate in preparation for the Paris lifting has hever been officially accounted for in the later stages of the interrupted negotiation, but the common assumption amongst speculative operators in United States Steel is that it is still held by the syndicate. For these reasons the return of Mr. Morgan is looked for to strengthen the hands of the friends of an increase in the steel dividend. The dragging tendency of United States Steel proved an obstacle to the efforts to advance prices.
