

RUSSELL, JAMES (*Charlotte*).

Grandfather, a native of Haddington, Scot., came to Halifax, N.S., with the Royal Engineers, fought in the Am. Revol. war, and afterwards settled in N.B. B. in St. Andrews, N.B., 15 Nov., 1824, and ed. there. M., 26 March, 1851, Agnes McDonald, of Wigton, Scot. Is a farmer, a magistrate and a County Councillor, and has been twice Warden of his Co. First returned to Ho. of Assem. at g. e., 1886, and re-elected at g. e., 1890, 1892 and 1895. A Liberal.—*Bayside, St. Croix, N.B.*

SCOVIL, GEORGE G. (*King's Co.*).

B. at Springfield, King's Co., in 1842, and ed. at Kingston, M. Miss Leah Spragg. Is a general storekeeper, and carries on a lumbering and farming business. Has been a Municipal Councillor for several years. First returned to Ho. of Assem. 1892, and re-elected at g. e., 1895. A Liberal.—*Bellisle Creek, Springfield.*

SEIVEWRIGHT, JOHN (*Gloucester*).

S. of John Seivewright, formerly principal of the Newcastle Grammar School. B. there 1846, and ed. at the Provincial Univ. Was Principal of Sydney, C.B., High School, and later of Harkins Seminary, Newcastle. Has been Secty. of the School Board, and is now Secy.-Treas. of Co. of Gloucester. An unsuccessful candidate at g. e., 1878. First returned to Ho. of Assem. at g. e., 1892. An Independent.—*Bathurst, N.B.*

SHAW, WILLIAM (*St. John City*).

B. 19 Sept., 1839, in the parish of Simonds, St. John Co., and was ed. at the public schools. M., 1870, Miss Isabella Wooten. Has been in the bakery business since 1868, and is also engaged in farming. Has been a City Alderman of St. John for some years, and was chairman for three years of the Public Works Department. Is also an active mem. of the County Agricultural Society. First returned to Leg. Assem. at g. e., 1890, and re-elected at last g. e. by acclamation. A Liberal-Conservative.—*St. John, N.B.*

SMITH, CHARLES L. (*Carleton*).

Of U.E. Loyalist descent. B. in 1853, and ed. in Local schools. M. Lenella McClary of Houlton. Is Presdt. of the Co. Assoc. of Patrons of Industry. Has been a mem.
