BILL.

An Act to incorporate "Les Clercs Paroissiaux ou
"Catéchistes de Saint Viateur," in the Village
of Industry, in the County of Berthier.

WHEREAS an Association hath existed for Preamble.
several years in the Village of Industry,
in the County of Berthier, under the name of
"Les Clercs Paroissiaux ou Catéchistes de
5 "Saint Viateur," for the instruction of young
persons in the sciences, and in the elements
thereof; and whereas the Members of the said
Association have, by their petition, prayed to
be incorporated, and, in consideration of the
10 great benefits which must arise from the In-
stitution, it is expedient to grant their prayer:

Be it therefore enacted, &c.: and it is here-
by enacted by the authority of the same, that
the Rev. François Thérèse Lahaye, Priest,
15 Etienne Champagneur, Augustin Fayard,
Louis Chrétien, Abraham Jacques Duhaut,
Paschal Lajoie, Louis Langlais, Joseph Vade-
bonceur, Octave Gaudreault, Godfroy Lacas,
and Gilbert Joly, the present officers and mem-
20 bers of the said Association, and such other
persons as shall hereafter become members of
the said Association according to the Rules
and Regulations thereof and the provisions of
this Act shall be, and they are hereby consti-
25 tuted and declared to be a body politic and
corporate, in deed and in name, by the name
of "*Les Clercs Paroissiaux ou Catéchistes de*
"*Saint Viateur*," and by that name shall have
perpetual succession and a common seal, and
30 shall have power, from time to time, to alter,
renew, or change such common seal at their
pleasure, and shall, by the same name, from
time to time, and at all times hereafter, be able
and capable to purchase, acquire, hold, possess
