

shall, on conviction of such offender, fine such offender in the said penalty, and shall cause the same to be levied as aforesaid.

Penalty on persons assisting others to evade tolls.

XXII. And be it enacted, That if any person or persons occupying or possessing any enclosed lands near any toll-houses or toll-gates which shall be erected in pursuance of this Act, shall knowingly permit or suffer any person or persons to pass through such lands, or through any gate, passage or way thereon, with any carriage, horse, mare, gelding or other animal liable to the payment of toll, whereby such payment shall be avoided, every person or persons so offending, and also the person riding or driving the animal or animals or carriage whereon such payment is avoided, being thereof convicted, shall, for every such offence, severally forfeit and pay any sum not exceeding shillings, which shall be laid out in improving such road.

Municipalities may acquire stock in Companies formed under this Act.

XXIII. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for any municipal body corporate, having jurisdiction within the locality through which any such road shall pass, to subscribe for, acquire, accept and hold, and to depart with and transfer stock in any Company to be formed under the authority of this Act, and from time to time to direct the Warden or other chief officer thereof, on behalf of such Municipality, to subscribe for such stock in the name of such Municipality, and to act for and on behalf of such Municipality in all matters relative to such stock and the exercise of the rights of such Municipality as a Stockholder, and the Warden or other chief officer, shall, whether otherwise qualified or not, be deemed a Stockholder in the Company, and may vote and act as such, subject always to such rules and orders in relation to his authority as shall be made in that behalf by such Municipality by their By-laws or otherwise, but acting according to his discretion in cases not provided

Who shall vote, &c., on such stock.
