Perfor shall be attached, and it shall be made appear to the Court out of which the Process of Attachment hath issued, that the Goods, Debts, and Credits fo attrohed are not fufficient to pay Twenty Shillings in the Pound to all those who shall be Creditors by reason of Debts contracted within the Island of Newfundland and on the Islands and Seas aforefaid, or on the Banks of Machand, or in Great Britain and Iroland, it shall be lawful for fuch Court to fummon the Party whose Goods, Debts, and Credits are so attached, together with the Plaintiff or Plaintiffs who have fued out any Attachment, and also such Persons who are known to be Creditors as aforefaid of the Defendant, to appear in Court at a certain Day; and if upon a due Examination of the Defendant and the faid Creditors, it shall appear that he or she is insolvent, the Court shall declare him or her infolvent accordingly, and shall immediately proceed to take order for discovering, collecting, and felling the Effects and Debts of fuch Person, and distributing the Produce thereof rateably amongst all the faid Creditors of fuch Person to declared infolvent, and for that Purpose shall authorize any One or more Creditors of the said Defendant, who shall be chosen by the major Part in Value of such Creditors, whose Debts amount respectively to the Sum of Ten Pounds and upwards, to perform the fame; and that fuch Court shall from Time to Time make fuch Order therein as shall be deemed proper for better discovering, collecting, and felling the Effects and Debts, and making a rateable Distribution thereof among the faid Creditors.

Distribution of Effects of infolvent Parties.

VII. And be it further enacted. That in the Distribution to be made of the Estate and Esfects of such Person to declared infolvent, every Fisherman and Seaman employed in the Fishery, who shall be a Creditor for Wages become due in the then current Sealon, shall first be paid Twenty Shillings in the Pound fo far as the Effects will go; and in the next Place every Person who shall be a Creditor for Supplies furnished in the current Serson shall be paid I wenty Shillings in the Pound; and in the next Place every Person who shall have become a Creditor within Two Years shall be paid Twenty Shillings in the Pound; and lastly, all other Creditors shall be paid equally as far as the Fliests will go.

Certifi atc of the Court to be a Bar to Suits for Declaration of Infelvency.

VIII. And to it further enacted, That it fuch infolvent Person shall make a true Disclosure and 1 iscovery of all his or her Goods and Esfects whatfoever, and shall conform him or her elf to the Order and Direction of Debt prior to the faid Court, the fame shall and may (with the Consent of One-half in Number and Value of his or her Creditors) be certified by the faid Court, and fuch Certificate, when pleaded, shall be a Bar to all Suits and Complaints for Debts contracted within the Island of Neverbundland and on the Islands and Seas aforelaid, and on the Banks of Newfoundland, and in Great Britain or Ireland, prior to the Time when he or she was declared Infolvent.

Chief Justice may grant Acminitintion of Effects.

IX. And be it further enacted, That the faid Chief Justice, or any Person or Persons appointed by him for that Purpose under his Hand and Seal, shall have Power to grant Administration of the Eslects of Intellates, and the Probate of Wills, and that the Effects of deceafed Persons shall not be administered within the Island of Newfoundland or on the Islands and Seas aforcfaid, or on the Banks of Newfoundland, unless Administration thereof, or Probate of Wills respecting the same, shall have been duly granted by fuch Authority as aforefaid.
