Dear Sir:-

referring to your application for an island close to Parry Island, I have to say that I wrote to the Department of Indian Affairs as you are aware on September 9th asking whether it claimed this as part of Parry Island, and have received a reply from that Department, dated 26th September in which it is stated that "the Department does not generally claim islands adjacent to Parry Island as part of the Reserve, but in the case referred to the island or promontory is unmistakably shown as a part of the Parry Island Reserve on a copy of the original plan of record in the Department. It has always been considered to form part of the reserve and under the control of the Department of Indian Affairs". Under these circumstances, therefore, it would seem that you would have to deal with the Department of Indian Affairs.
