650,000. The value of the field crops in 1929 was \$90,000,000 and the gross agricultural revenue is estimated to be over \$150,000,000.

Last year the manufactured industries made a new record of \$165,000,000.

Mining operations likewise broke all records in claims, state and actual developments. The natural resources are tremendous. The people of the Province in their celebration next month will be fully justified in telling the rest of Canada of their remarkable progress in little more than half a century. Manitoba's growth in the near future promises to be even greater than in the last couple of decades.
