

direction to Horse Lake as shown on Mr. London's sketch, cannot be the true Easterly boundary.

There appears to be no doubt that the true Easterly boundary of the grounds leased to the St. Clair Flats Shooting Company, according to the description in the lease and as illustrated in the sketch enclosed, is the western edge of the outlet from Johnson's Lake, the western shore of Johnson Lake and the western edge of the outlet from Horse Lake to Johnson Lake.
