Sir,

Referring to your letter of the 15th instant, with which you forwarded an account from Dr Tozer for professional services rendered to Indians of your Agency, I beg to say that the Department is prepared to pay for the visits (four) which were made under instructions from you, but will not be responsible for settlement in the other cases.

If Dr Tozer attended the Indians in the absence of Dr. Doherty, the latter should pay for the services rendered. The Department does not propose to pay a physician a salary and at the same time pay another medical man for attending to the work.

You should have Dr Tozer prepare a new account containing only charges for the attendance authorized. The account submitted is returned herewith. The new account should be sent in before the first of May.
