


OTTAWA, 2nd December, 1918-

Sir-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of letter from you of the 25th Ultimo, in regard to Resolution No 3, relative to purchase by the Band from John T. McDougall and sale to William H. Laform of the S.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Lot 6 and the W  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Lot 5, Con 1, Tuscarora, for the sum of \$600.00, to be paid for in annual instalments of \$150.00 with Interest at 6%.

In reply, I beg to say that the Resolution, in accordance with your recommendation, is hereby approved, and you may now proceed to make the usual arrangements for leasing the land, in order that the payments may be credited on the purchase thereof.
