In article "Germany Attacks Russia - Galley 84, in 3rd paragraph - after the words "the subjugation of Russia" insert the following marked "A" which begins: "The day Hitler seeks to outflank" and ends "the whole continent of Asia".

In the line following - "if successful in this purpose" - change words "this" to "his".

At the end of galley, after the words "Western world" insert, as a new paragraph the following, marked "B":

"The chief obstacle to Nazi ambitions is still Britain, and Britain can afford to devote but a part of her effort to other theatres of war. The threat of invasion of her own island has not passed. The Battle of the Atlantic has not been won".
