Sir,

I have the honor to inform you that, at an extraordinary meeting of the Board, held on the 21st inst, Dr. Jos. Poirchaud laid before the Board a letter from you, enclosing one from Drs. Moirin, Hall and Parent, stating that there was no Quorum in the Board, when a certificate was granted to Mr. Jos. Smith, on the 7th inst., declaring him qualified to practice the Medical profession; and in compliance with your request that His Excellency the Governor in chief may be furnished with such observations as the Board may see fit to offer, it was then resolved, unanimously, that such parts of the minutes of the proceedings of the Board on the 7th inst. as relate to Mr. Smith, be forthwith transmitted for His Excellency's information.
