Replying to your letter, date and file number above noted, I beg to return, herewith, the four copies of the above licence with the following observation: The attached renewal does not make any mention of authority being granted to the Company for using a portable saw-mill on the Reserve and, as that privilege is really back of the whole long-term-plan proposed by the Logging Company in their letter of May 19th, it would not be worthwhile for me to send the licence to them for completion without the clause authorizing operations of the mill on the Reserve being inserted. I am, therefore, returning, herewith, the draft licence with the request that a clause along the lines requested be inserted.
