for a period of three years and for the reappointment of A.D. Dunton, Governor and Chairman of the Corporation for a similar period.

(Minister's recommendations, P.C.5019, 5020, 5021, Nov.10, 1948).

10. The Cabinet, after discussion, approved the Minister's recommendations and agreed that Orders in Council be passed accordingly.

Income tax forms, 1948

11. The Minister of National Revenue submitted two revised forms for return on individual incomes for the tax year 1948 - T.1 short form, applicable to individuals whose income did not include investment income over \$1,800, and T.1 general, applicable to all other individuals, including farmers and fishermen.

(Draft forms T.1 short form and T.1 general, 1948).

12. Dr.McCann explained the changes made in the new short form which would be applicable for some 87% of all tax payers. T.l general had also been simplified. There would hereafter be no special form for farmers.

The new forms had been the subject of special consideration and discussion; expert investigators had determined that they were a great improvement on the old.

13. The Cabinet, after discussion, approved the revised forms, T.1 short form and T.1 general, as submitted by the Minister.

Trans-Canada Highway; conference with Provinces

14. The Minister of Mines and Resources, referring to discussion at the meeting of October 20th, reported that replies had been received from all of the Provincial Premiers expressing their willingness to be represented at a meeting on the highway problem.
