

The agreement provided that the Chairman of the Board be appointed by the Governor in Council with the concurrence of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council of Manitoba. It also provided that one member of the Board be appointed by the Governor in Council to represent the Government of Canada. Recommendations for the respective appointments were submitted.

16. The Cabinet, after discussion, approved the recommendations of the Minister of Trade and Commerce and the agreement entered into by him on behalf of the Government of Canada with the Government of Manitoba, and agreed:

(a) that the Greater Winnipeg Dyking Board be established to consist of members appointed from time to time as set forth in the agreement;

(b) that J.B. Carswell, Esquire, be appointed, subject to concurrence of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council of Manitoba, as Chairman of the Board at a salary of \$100 per day together with actual travelling and living expenses while engaged in the work of the Board, the appointment to be effective from the date of concurrence by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council of Manitoba; and,

(c) that Victor Michie, Esquire, be appointed a member of the Board at a salary of \$600 per month; Orders in Council to be passed accordingly.

International Joint Commission, appointment; terms of office

17. The Prime Minister submitted a recommendation for appointment of a member of the Canadian section of the International Joint Commission. The Prime Minister pointed out that the statute establishing the Commission did not provide any term for appointments. It seemed desirable that some term should be specified and possibly consideration should be given to amendment of the Act at the next Session of Parliament.

18. The Secretary of State for External Affairs said that he thought it would be desirable to give similar consideration to the terms of appointment of all international boards and commissions on which Canada had membership.

19. The Cabinet, after discussion:

(a) approved the appointment of Lucien Dansereau, Esquire, to be a member of the Canadian section of the International Joint Commission; an Order in Council to be passed accordingly;
