can give the floor and wall of her box-stall a shower bath every day or two. Continue this until the foal is almost two weeks of age, or until the navel is entirely healed and dried up. Imme-diately after the birth of the colt bathe continue to do this every day, or twice a day, for a short time at first. Be careful about allowing the colt to lie down in other places than thus treated until the navel is healed up. This treatment is inexpensive, and is well worth the trouble.
