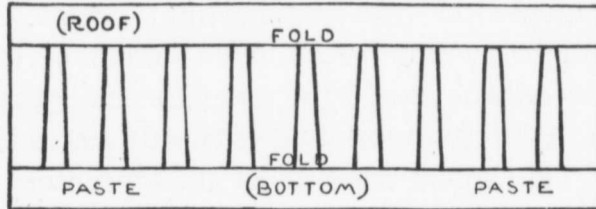
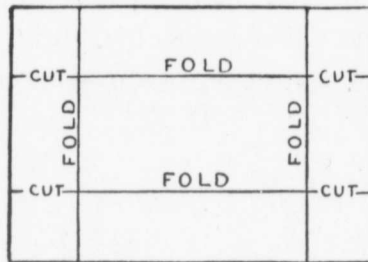

Fold two strips of paper into three parts as in Figure 1, and mark some lines to look like the tall marble pillars of the great porches. Paste the bottom on the solid lines in the plan of the Temple. Cut two similar pieces for the front and back, and cut a little opening at the place where the steps are indicated. Make the corners square like this,  letting one piece slip over the other. Cut a straight piece of paper, to fit in as a roof.

A narrow piece of paper might be folded and pasted on the very outside line for the wall.

To represent the building in the center, take a piece of white paper and fold it like Figure 2. Cut where it says "cut," and paste the loose ends to make a little open box. Cut a door so that you can see inside.
