shall be impowered to cause process to be issued against all and every perfon and perfons who shall stand indebted for duties longer than three Months allowed for the payment thereof.

If the Treasurer fhall not caufe proceis to iffue at the end of 3 months the duties in arrears thall be deemed affets in his hands.

VII. And be it further enacted, That if the faid Treasurer fball not cause process to be made for any duties to arise by virtue of this act at the end of the faid three Months, hereby limited for the payment thereof, fuch duties, and the arrears thereof, as he shall so omit to sue for, shall be deemed affets in his hands; and he shall in such case be answerable for the same accordingly.

Treaferer to appoint deputies to be approved of by the Lt. Governor, in thefeveral countics who fhall give good fecurity to the Treaforer for the faithful discharge of their duty, and thali have 10 per cent, for their uouble,

Money to remain in the treasury till disposed of by act of Affembly.

VIII. And be it further enacted, That the Treasurer of the Province, for the time being, fhall nominate fit perfons to be approved of by the Lieutenant-Governor in the feveral counties in this province, to receive the leveral duties and impolitions laid and imposed by this act, which perfons to appointed thall give good and fufficient fecurity to fech Treafurer, for the faithful difcharge of their duty, and to be accountable for all fums to to be received by virtue of this ad, to the Treasurer, when thereunto required, which perfor fo appointed thall have and retain ten pounds for every hundred pounds, they shall so receive in full for their trouble and fervices.

IX. And be it further enasted, That all the money to arife by virtue of this act, shall remain in the Treasury until the same shall be disposed of by an act or acts of the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Allembly, to be palled for that purpose.

X. And be it enacted, That this act shall continue and be Act to be in force in force for eighteen Months and no longer.

An ACT for securing the Purcha-SERS OF MORTGAGED ESTATES.
