Thanks for your kindness in allowing me the privilege of appealing at this Christmas time on behalf of the Hospital for Sick Children, Toronto.

I make this direct appeal to the neoule of Ontario, for the fathers and mothers of Ontario, outside the City of Toronto, have precisely the same claim for their sick children as regards the

rivileges of the Hospital, as parents who reside in this city.

In brief the sick children from any place in Ontario whose parents canno afford to pay, is, on certificate from a municipal officer of any city, towa, village or township, treated free.

This is a privilege not granted by any Hospital in the Dominion, or on this continent.

Let me, in a few words, state that in the last 20 years, since 1891, there have been 4,731 patients from 450 places outside of this city treated free, as the parents were unable to pay for treat-ment. Last year 384 patients from 384 places outside Toronto were so treated. The Hospital is not a city but a Provincial institution. The Corporation of Toronto grants \$18,000, not only for city, children, but towards the mainten-ance of every patient in the Hospital,

ance of every patient in the Hospital, and the citizens of Toronto donate an average of \$10,000 to the maintenance fund of the Hospital.

It would take more space than you can spare to tell of the good work done for the sick and deformed children of this Province.



Location.

In determining the location of the lee-house, a place should be chosen where the building can be well drained by an underground line of drain tile. If possible, it should be placed where the shade of large trees, or larger structures, will protect it from the heat of the midday sun.

The concrete for the walls should be made of Portland cement, clean sand and a hard crushed rock or screened gravel. Instead of the sand and rock, clean bank-run gravel may be used.

Naturally, the size of the ice-house will depend upon the number of pounds needed daily and the number of of days loe will be used. A cubic foot of ice weighs about 57 pounds, and a ton, with 10 per cent, allowance for seams between the cakes, occupies 38 cubic feet.
