Against Tariff Increases Asked By The Manufaca turesr Sittle

RESOLUTIONS ARE PASSED

Ottawa, Dec. 15.—The Liberal members from Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta waited on the Minister of Finance Thursday afternoon and registered their protest against any increases in the Canadian tariff, as asked for by the manufacturers. Since the new tariff was introduced, the manufacturers have been making demands upon the Government for increases amounting in some cases to as high as 10 per cent.

The western members told Mr. Fielding, that while they would have liked to have seen a still lower tariff in the interests of the farmers, they accepted the schedule as presented to Parliament as a fair compromise.

The delegation made it perfectly clear that any increase would be stubbornly resisted and resented by the farming community of the three, provinces.
